Mark O'Hern was appointed president of WVU Medicine East in November 2024.

Prior to his current role, he served as president of UPMC East and UPMC McKeesport for 6 years where he was responsible for business development and strategic planning in support of the successful operation of UPMC East and UPMC McKeesport.

Before his time as president, Mr. O'Hern served as vice president of operations at UPMC East and UPMC McKeesport, where he provided executive leadership for the day-to-day operations of both hospitals. He has also been executive director of UPMC Children's Community Pediatrics (CCP), where he was responsible for leading the operational aspects of the largest pediatric and adolescent primary care medical network in Western Pennsylvania, the director of cardiovascular services for UPMC Presbyterian Shadyside, the flagship hospitals for UPMC and several other positions within the UPMC system.

Mr. O'Hern is a past president of the Cornell University Human Ecology Alumni Association Board. He served for three years as a board member for the Wilmerding/McKeesport YMCA. Current board positions include March of Dimes Western PA, Sampson Family YMCA, as well as McKee Point Development Group.

Mr. O'Hern was previously Executive Director of UPMC Administrative Fellowship Program and currently faculty at Pitt MHA Program. He will be the primary preceptor with weekly 1-1 meetings with the resident and exposure to other high-level meetings including executive management group, medical executive, board meetings, etc. Mr. O'Hern has been facilitating summer residents for over 10 years at UPMC and looks forward to launching this summer resident program for WVU Medicine East.

Mr. O'Hern holds a master's degree in health administration from Cornell University and a Bachelor of Science in policy analysis and management from Cornell University.



GRANTS PROCESS

- Applicant must be a non-profit charitable organization, government agency, Rotary Foundation, or other Rotary Club.
- Must demonstrate need for a specific project, pilot program, or program (not to include operating and/or administrative expenses such as salaries and operating expenses or ongoing operations—i.e., we will not provide a grant to a Food Pantry to buy food).
- Must be able to demonstrate impact of the grant.
- Funding must provide services to Berkeley County residents (exceptions can be made for other Rotary Clubs)
- Funding must be for future projects or programs. (Grants may not be used to reimburse organizations for activities or expenses already completed or in progress.)




WHO? AND WHAT?

Grants for a maximum of \$20,000.00 per organization will support projects that demonstrate need for small capital items or "seed money" for pilot programs and special services that provide direct and tangible benefits within Martinsburg/ Berkeley County or larger projects or pilot programs that demonstrate long-term sustainability and impact.



SEVEN AREAS OF FOCUS

All grant applications must relate to the seven areas of focus for Rotary International: Promoting peace; Fighting disease; Providing clean water; Sanitation, and hygiene; Saving mothers and children and supporting education; Growing local economies; Protecting the environment.



Non-profits in the community are encouraged to apply for the grants Dec. 1, 2024 through Jan. 31, 2025.
