Friends of Momance

Momance is a small village in Leogane, Haiti. The people of Momance faced many challenges on a daily basis when we began our mission over ten years ago. There was no well or running water, no electricity, poor living conditions, no school, and most were living on 2 dollars a day or less. In 2010, Leogane was the epicenter of a devastating earthquake which left thousands dead and much of the area reduced to rubble. As the dust settled, the village leaders of Momance gathered and put together a committee, which formed a vision for the future of Momance. They wanted a better place for their children and their community.

With prayer and diligence, these leaders worked to reach out to others. God moved in the hearts of some volunteers who were in Haiti on different medical trips. These volunteers carried the vision for Momance home with them, shared it with others, and soon Friends Of Momance was formed.

By the Fall of 2012 a well was built in Momance, and by 2013 Phase One of the construction was complete, with 2 classrooms, and the school started. This school was named Les Pionniers de Momance School. In 2021, we completed our fifth phase of construction, and in 2022 we partnered with P4H to provide our teachers with professional training.

There are now over 225 students in school, with 10 classrooms, a chapel, an office, and a playground. We are servicing children in pre-school to eighth grade. Each child also receives a hot breakfast and lunch daily. With the recent addition of monthly medical and dental clinics, we are now able to provide the children and their families with education, nutrition, and better health.

We have made great progress in Momance, but there remains work to do. We hope to construct a community pavilion in 2023.

Our prayer is for a self-sustaining community of Momance with empowered Haitian citizens making a positive difference in their community and world.
