Did you know that Steve Roach's Mom, Joan Roach, was a founder of CCAP? In addition to that we learned that in WV 15% of it's 1.7 Mil residents rely on SNAP benefits. The average cost of fent in Berkeley Co. is \$1,600/mo. Those living at or below the poverty line: 11.4% Berkeley County, 22.97% Martinsburg, and 13% of BC children. CCAP services include supplying nutritionally dense food to those in need, utility assistance, rental assistance, work shoes, Rx Co-pays, and transportation vouchers. Number of households that have been helped as of November 24, 2025: Food – 3,462, Rent – 151, Electric – 94, Water/Sewer – 90, Heating – 9, Prescriptions – 60 and Work Shoes – 95. The average # Households Receiving Food (Jan.1 – Sept. 30) = 291 and the total # Households Receiving Food During Govt. Shutdown = 712.




Feed the Joy: Christmas Dinner Kits for Families.
