Martinsburg Rescue Mission

Pastor Timothy Guerino



Pastor Tim Guerino was the speaker this week. He discussed a current project the Martinsburg Rescue Mission has been campaigning for. He brought in some mockups to illustrate what the completed project, housing for six homeless families would look like. Pastor Tim also discussed his recent contributions and efforts in Ukraine. I found this passage for those who were unable to attend the meeting in person....

"Martinsburg Union Rescue Superintendent Pastor Timothy Guerino continues his mission work in Eastern Europe. He is with a group of nurses and a doctor who are on the ground providing aid to those suffering during the war in Ukraine.

"We are at the Romania and Ukraine border walking folks from Ukrainian to Romania and then providing food for them as they wait to go through the tents to get help," Pastor Tim wrote. He relates the story of a young man he says "has been here in Romania for two months. He was waiting for his two sisters to cross his sister just had the baby in Odessa the baby is two months old she had to leave her husband back there and Odessa."

In an update a few hours later on Friday morning, Pastor Tim said he was likely going to have a long day, spending "the rest of the day here and tomorrow will be in Ukraine all day it's gonna be a long day," he said. "Got to be down here by seven in the morning to catch the ferry over and we're gonna be in the many cities tomorrow." He closed his message with "God bless, Tim."
