**1 New Year's Day**, the first day of the year according to the modern Gregorian calendar, celebrated in most Western countries.

**1 Feast Day of St. Basil**, a holiday observed by the Eastern Orthodox Church, commemorating the death of Saint Basil the Great.

**3 Feast of the Holy Name of Jesus**, which is celebrated in the Roman Catholic Church, commemorates the naming of the child Jesus.

**4 World Braille Day**, observed to raise awareness of the importance of Braille as a means of communication for blind and partially sighted people; celebrated on the birthday of Louis Braille, the inventor of Braille.

**5 Twelfth Night**, a festival celebrated by some branches of Christianity that marks the coming of the Epiphany.

**6 Epiphany or Dia de los Reyes (Three Kings Day)**, a holiday observed by Eastern and Western Christians recognizing the visit of the three wise men to the baby Jesus twelve days after his birth.

**7 Christmas**, recognized on this day by Eastern Orthodox Christians, who celebrate Christmas thirteen days later than other Christian churches because they follow the Julian calendar rather than the Gregorian version.

**7 Mahayana New Year**, a holiday celebrated by the Mahayana Buddhist branch on the first full-moon day in January.

**13 Maghi/Lohri**, an annual festival celebrated by Sikhs commemorating the memory of forty Sikh martyrs.

**14 Makar Sankranti**, major harvest festival celebrated in various parts of India.

**15 World Religion Day**, observed by those of the Bahá'í faith to promote interfaith harmony and understanding.

**16 Martin Luther King Jr. Day** commemorates the birth of the Rev. Martin Luther King Jr., the recipient of the 1964 Nobel Peace Prize and an activist for nonviolent social change until his assassination in 1968.

**18-25 The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity**, during which Christians pray for unity between all churches of the Christian faith.

**19 Timkat**, a holiday observed by Ethiopian Orthodox Christians who celebrate the baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River on Epiphany.

**20 Birthday of Guru Gobind Singh Ji**, the Tenth Guru of the Sikhs, who initiated the Sikhs as the Khalsa (the pure ones) and who is known as the Father of the Khalsa.

**22 Lunar New Year**, one of the most sacred of all traditional Chinese holidays, a time of family reunion and celebration. The Lunar New Year is also celebrated at this time in Japan, Korea, Vietnam, and Mongolia.

**26 Republic Day of India** recognizes the date when the Constitution of India came into law in 1950, replacing the Government of India Act of 1935. This day also coincides with India's 1930 declaration of independence.

**26 Vasant Panchami**, the Hindu festival that highlights the coming of spring. On this day, Hindus worship Saraswati Devi, the goddess of wisdom, knowledge, music, art, and culture.

**27 The International Day of Commemoration** remembers the victims of the Holocaust; the anniversary of the liberation of the Auschwitz death camp in 1945; and the UN Holocaust Memorial Day.

**27 (sundown to sundown) Holocaust Remembrance Day** is a time to "mourn the loss of lives, celebrate those who saved them, honor those who survived, and contemplate the obligations of the living." —Former President Barack Obama
